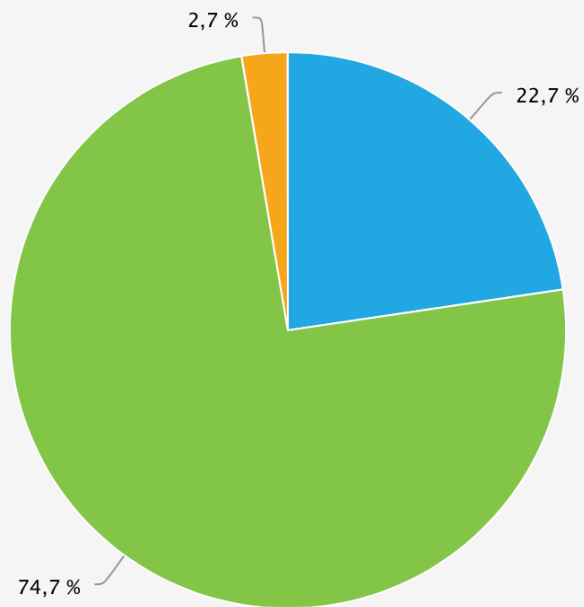

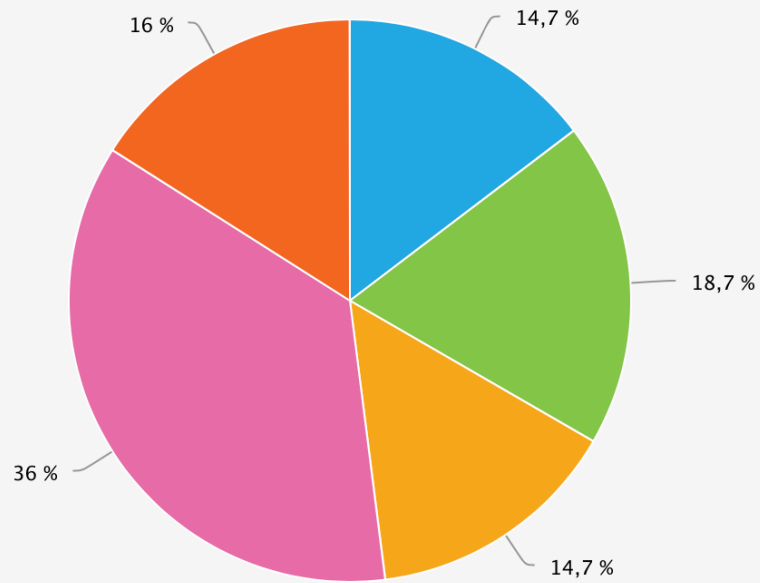

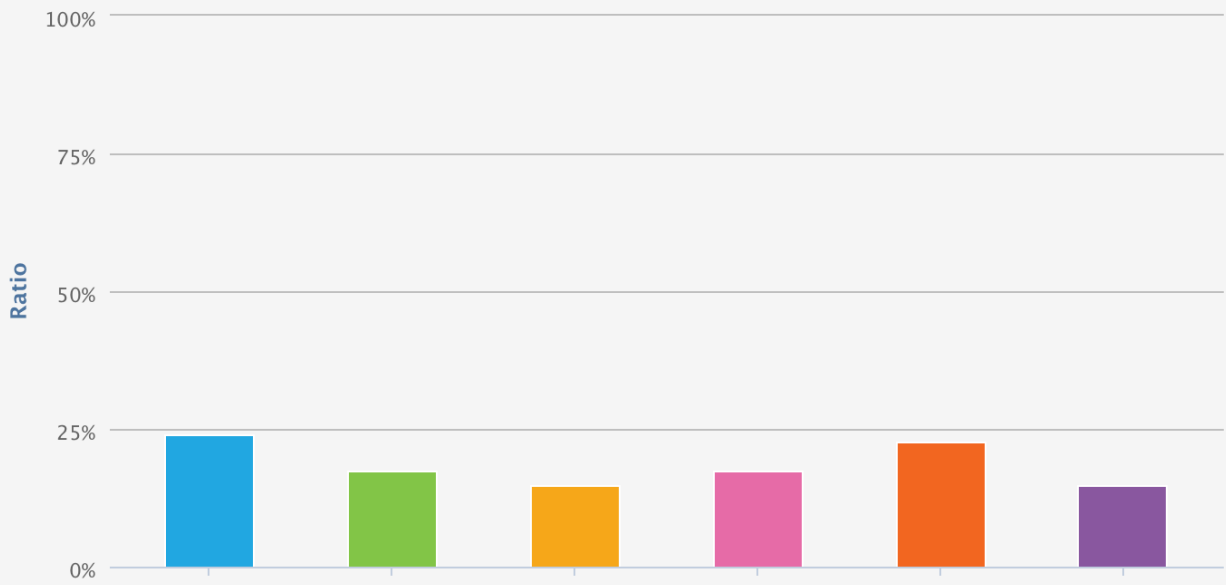

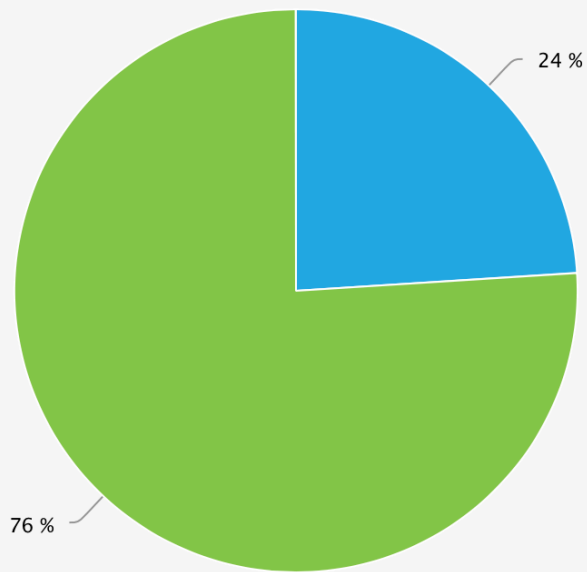

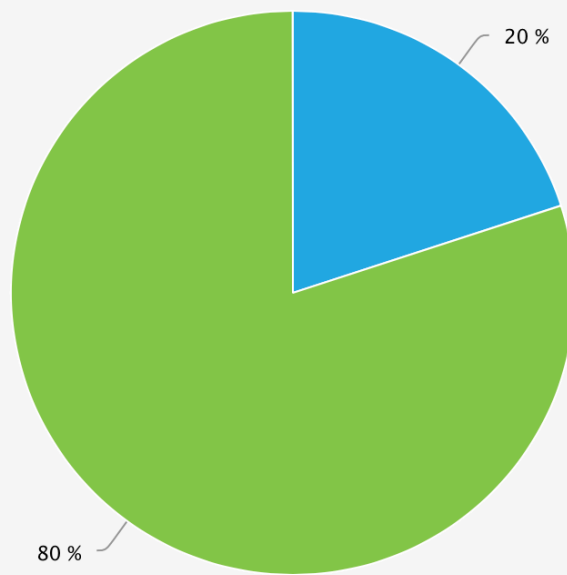

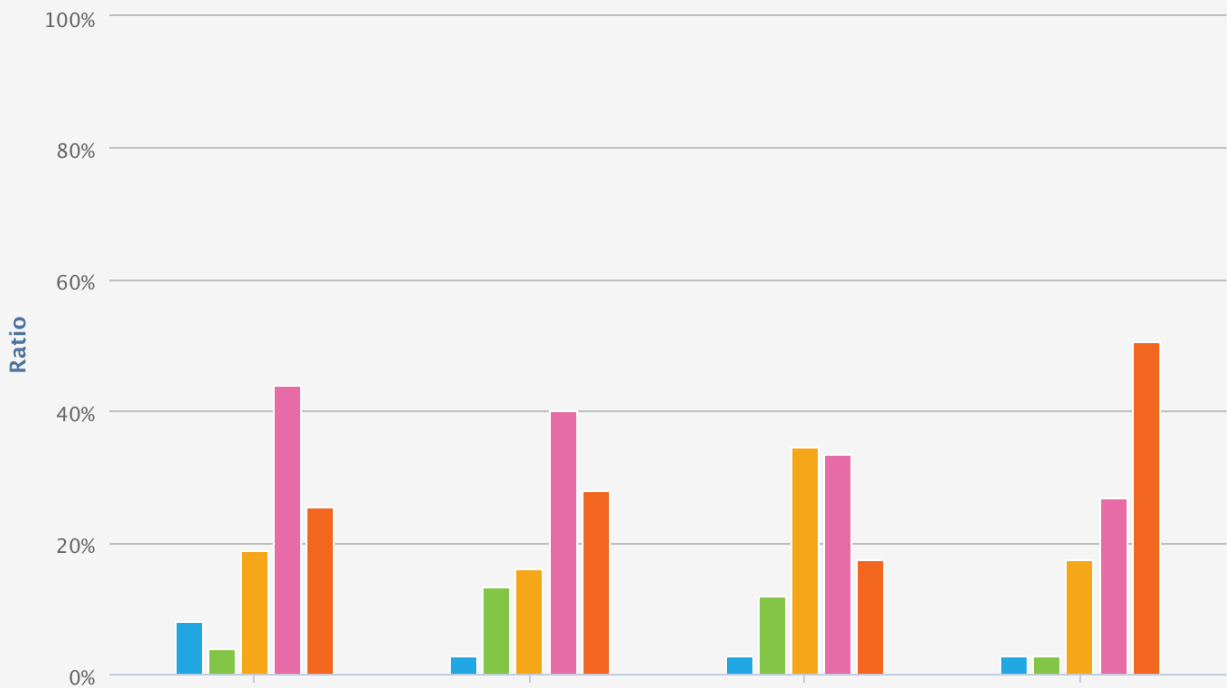

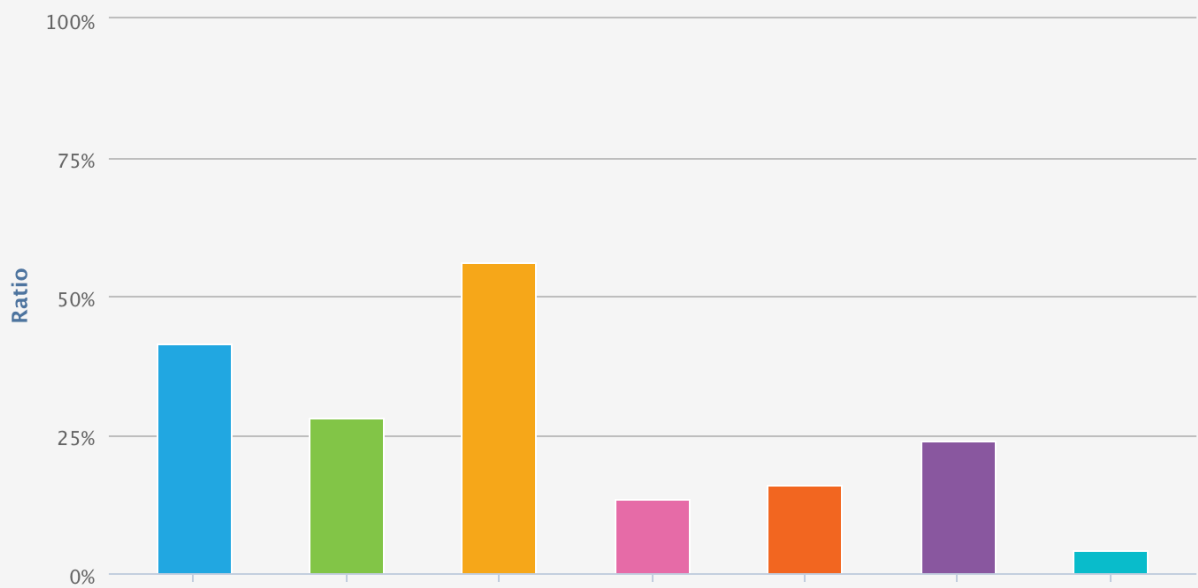

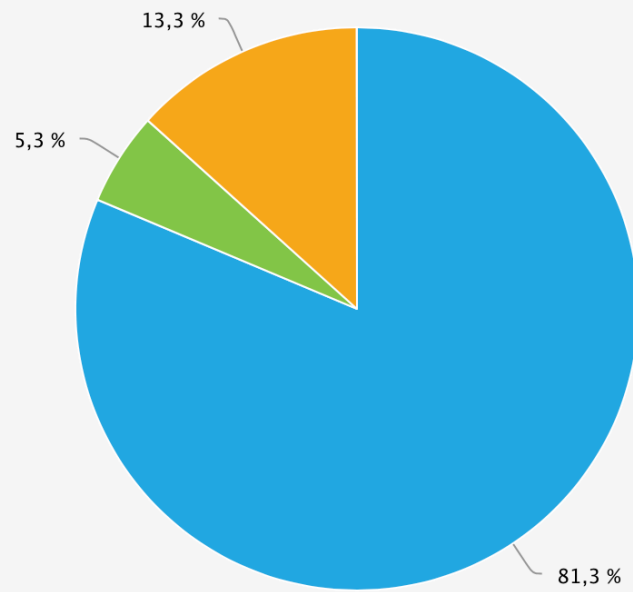

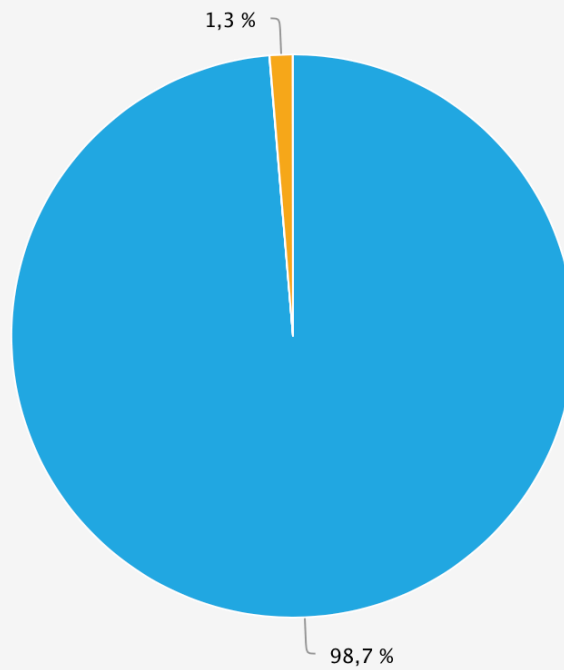

12 Do you think being in another country is an advantage for the project?



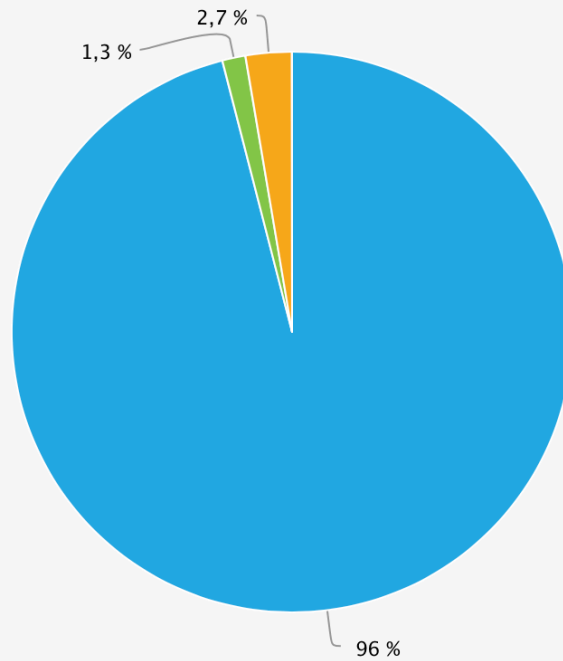

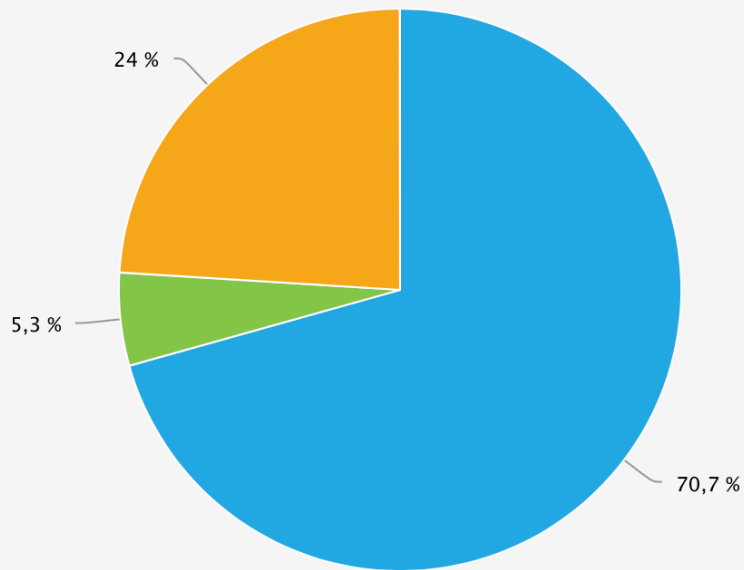

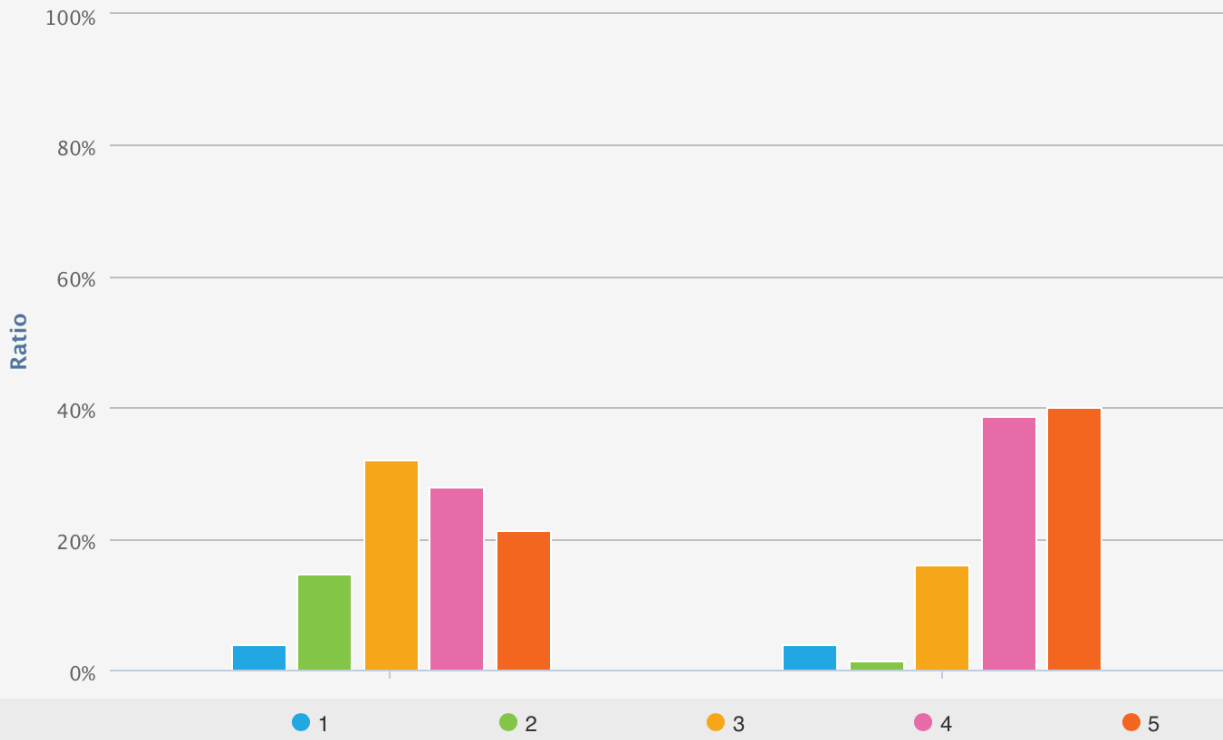
